Procedure for selection of the recipient of the «AQIPA Clinical Research Prize »

Description

The AQIPA prize for clinical research is subsidized by the Commission de la Santé et Sécurité au travail du Québec (CSST). A maximum amount of 500\$ is granted. If the prize for fundamental research is not given, a second prize of 500\$ may be allocated to clinical research.

The objective of this prize is to acknowledge clinical research with people who have had a limb amputation, to stimulate health-care professionals' interest in research, to encourage future research and to bridge the gap between caregivers and researchers.

Criteria for award of the AQIPA prize for clinical research

- The candidate must be a health-care professional, an MSc or PhD student, an administrator or researcher affiliated to a health establishment or social services in the province of Québec.
- The candidate must deliver a lecture at the AQIPA's biennial congress. The lecture must have a scientific orientation and present outcomes of a clinical research or literature review.
- Preference will be given to candidates who have not previously received the prize.

Selection procedure

- Three evaluators attend the lecture of the eligible candidate.
- The lecture is evaluated according to the following criteria:
 - Clinical pertinency of the research,
 - Scientific content of the presentation,
 - Quality of the oral, audio-visual presentation.
- An evaluation form was developed.
