

AQIPA

Criteria for the awarding of educational activity grants

Concerning the applicant

- The application must be completed and received at least 1 month before the activity.
- The applicant's work must be directly related to the amputee population.
- The applicant must be a member of the AQIPA.
- The practice of the applicant must be in a (health) institution of the province of Québec.

Concerning the educational activity

- The activity must be directly related to the amputation population.
- The activity can be a scholarly activity, or attendance at a conference or congress which is directly related to the amputee population. The applicant must provide a detailed, written summary of the activity.
- The applicant must explain the impact of the activity on health services or other services to the amputee population.
- The applicant must provide a detailed report of the activity to the AQIPA, either written or oral. The report may be presented at a congress or conference.

Concerning finances and frequency of the awarding of the grant:

- The amount awarded cannot exceed 500 dollars per person.
- The amount cannot exceed 50% of the total cost of the activity.
- A total amount of 1000 dollars is allocated for all requests each year, at the beginning of the fiscal year. The unused amounts may not be transferred to the following year.
- Only one grant may be allocated to one person within a period of 3 years.
- Only one grant may be allocated to one institution within a period of 1 year.
